### Position: Crops Production Assistant

We are hiring a full-time Crops Production Assistant at all farm locations. In this role you will work directly with the farm's Crop and Dairy Managers. you will lead crop production projects as well as farm and facility maintenance projects. These projects may include planting, harvesting, manure pumping, and general repair and construction projects. This position will require some traveling between our different farm sites.

### Responsibilities:

- Lead a team project from start to completion
- Help with harvest of corn silage and haylage, and manure pumping/hauling
- Be able to be away from home during harvest seasons (We do harvest work in Kansas, South Dakota, and Minnesota) Drive truck, packing tractor, feeder wagons, manure spreaders, tractors\*
- Perform inventory of shop supplies and equipment
- Order mechanical supplies and keep inventory stocked for the shop
- Perform general farm construction and repairs
  - Fixing and repairing free stall barns
  - Pouring and forming concrete
  - General electrical and plumbing work

\*During cropping and Manure season you would be expected to work longer days/hours roughly 75 to 85 hours per week. During the off season you will be expected to work 55 to 65 hours per week.

- Ability to work in a team and lead projects
- Passion for growing crops and sustaining farmland
- Not required to have CDL but we will help acquire one if needed

**Physical requirements of the job:**

- Lift 50 pounds
- Work in heights
- Willing to operate heavy machinery
- Interact with cattle
- Be around dust, dirt, and work in cold and hot weather
