Position: Dairy Farm Manager

We are hiring a full-time Dairy Farm Manager at all farm locations. In this role you will lead, inspire, and manage the farm as a whole with the goal of a safe, healthy, and comfortable environment for your team and animals in mind. This position entails employee management of all farm management teams (Herdspersons, Milker/Scrapers, Mechanic, Feeders, Calves, Maternity, Dry Cows).

Responsibilities:

- Execute protocols and monitor results of animal reproduction, milking, nutrition, and general repairs
- Provide support and knowledge to employees along with training and re-training of protocols
- Lead management teams to complete their jobs efficiently and effectively
- Perform inventory of feed stuffs and purchase feeds monthly
- Manage fall harvest of corn silage by recording data, run dry matter percent, and cover silage pile
- Work with fall manure pumping to take samples and record data from fields
- Dairy farm managers are expected to work 55 to 65 hours per week. Sometimes you will have to be available over weekends and holidays in cases of emergency. (You have the ability to set your work schedule to have a positive work, home, and life balance.)

Preferred Qualifications:

- Previous experience working on a dairy farm
- Minimum of 1 year of experience in a leadership role
- Not required to speak Spanish, but will be given learning opportunities

Physical requirements of the job:

- Lift 50 pounds
- Work in heights
- Willing to operate heavy machinery
- Interact with cattle
- Be around dust, dirt, and work in cold and hot weather
